Carl Bohl has told me of your inquiry concerning the possibility of doing animal or human studies to show conclusively that 2,4,5-T with its low concentration of TDD as currently produced is not acnogenic. The science (art?) of devising studies has not developed to the point where conclusive answers could be obtained with any species.

It is my belief that even one ppm of TDD could cause chloracne problems if workmen did not take the same precautions in avoiding exposure which have been practiced with higher levels of TDD. If we are to avoid even occasional and possibly mild cases of skin reaction, I believe there can be no let up in all of the preventive measures which at least have minimized the number of cases in the recent past.
